The wood was cut in October 2015: part was "thermo cooked" for outdoor use and part, destined to floors and furnishings, was laid natural.

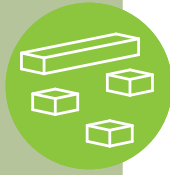
The selection process and the use of local materials testify the particular attention of the Cantina for the natural products and the value of the territory.



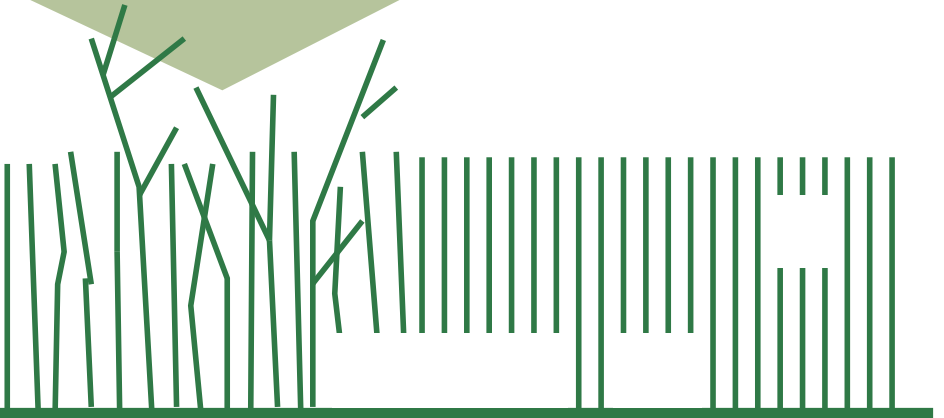

The Cansiglio Forest, also known as the "Grande Bosco da Reme" (Great Forest of Rowing) from the Republic of Venice, has historical, botanical, faunal and landscape value. It is certified as PEFC, Programme for Endorsement of Forest Certification, ie according to the principles of sustainable forest management, which ensures the preservation and the appropriate development of the forest resources, safeguarding the biological diversity and the ecosystem of the woodland, maintaining the other functions of the forest, in addition to those productive.
